## **Code of Ethics**

Ethics is now globally recognised as an essential component of professional knowledge. It is particularly relevant where professionals are in a position of public trust as is the case with a rating agency. This code is intended to guide the activities and decision-making of all personnel of CariCRIS including the Board, Rating Committee and staff members.

## All personnel of CariCRIS shall:

- 1. Act in an ethical and professional manner at all times, with integrity, fairness and dignity towards clients, prospects, public, fellow employees and other members of the organisation.
- 2. Ensure that CariCRIS conforms to the highest standards of best practice in the provision of its services.
- 3. Exercise utmost care and due-diligence in accessing, using, analysing and disseminating information.
- 4. Strive to continually improve individual competence and be committed to the sharing of knowledge in order to nurture a learning organisation.
- 5. Be very alert to conflict of interest and any such conflict, actual or perceived, shall be declared promptly by the person who has the conflict or any other person, aware thereof.
